



#### LYNDOCH HISTORICAL SOCIETY

Work was commenced on the \$913000 redevelopment of the Lyndoch Primary School in April 1992 to include extra classrooms, administrative centre, landscaping, car parking and playing areas.


Unfortunately, on 14th November that same year the worst flood "in living memory" hit Lyndoch about 2 o'clock in the afternoon when 3 inches fell in 2 hours. The township centre was awash with Gilbert Street and Barossa Highway roads turning into rivers. Much of the loose dirt (becoming mud from the school property) was washed down into Gilbert Street.



Redeveloped Lyndoch Primary School – Official Opening 22nd May 1994 Thirty years ago. the official opening of the redeveloped primary school was performed by Mr Malcolm Buckby MP, when he unveiled a plaque to commemorate the event. After the opening parents and children planted 300 trees in the school grounds. A book titled "Slates to Computers" was published for the occasion.

#### Council invests in community infrastructure

The Barossa Council's draft budget for 2024-25

is underpinned by investment in community infrastructure, including roads, footpaths and community facilities.

The draft budget, out for public consultation from 15 May to 7 June, proposes an average 4.3% increase in general rate revenue, in line with CPI increases.

In recognition of the challenges facing rural businesses, an effective rate freeze will be in place for rural ratepayers for one year.

Mayor Bim Lange said the upcoming budget is focused on upgrading core infrastructure and building maintenance to future-proof these community assets.

"We've budgeted over \$3.3 million to renew and upgrade roads, and we're doubling our footpath budget over the next 10 years to address a backlog of works on the existing network," Mayor Lange said.

"We're also commencing a longterm plan to upgrade our public toilets, plus renewing community assets such as the pool decking at the Rex, Old Union Chapel flooring and a rebuild of Tanunda Kegel Club, so our community can continue to enjoy contemporary community facilities.

"We're also looking ahead to the next stage of investment and funding opportunities, including repurposing Williamstown oval, a second oval at Stockwell and equestrian investment at Talunga Park in Mount Pleasant." cils proposing significant rate increases.

# Funding flows to Creative Industries Centre The Barossa Council has received multi-million dol-

lar funding partnership support from the Albanese and Malinauskas Governments, with the announcement of two successful grants to deliver the vision for a Barossa Creative Industries Centre, which has been a generation in the making.


Council will redevelop Barossa Regional Gallery at Tanunda into a landmark \$13.92 million cultural hub and creative industry precinct.

Council has received \$6,961,000 for the Centre under the Albanese Commonwealth Government's Growing Regions Program – Round 1, as well as \$500,000 to develop the external precinct under the Malinauskas State Government's Open Space grant program.


