#### LYNDOCH HISTORICAL SOCIETY

The next meeting of the Lyndoch Historical Society will be held on Sunday 4th August at 2.00 p.m. in the Meeting Room at the rear of the Lyndoch Library. Continuing the World War theme the topic will revert back 85 years to 1939 when WWII commenced.

In 1974 the Barossa District Council and the Lyndoch Tourism Group had combined to enable a beautification scheme for the landscape in and around Lyndoch. With Arbor Day held in August each year by schools it was decided to invite both Lyndoch schools to be involved in planting trees so that phase one of the beautification scheme could be completed.

Fifty years ago, on 22nd August 1974 children from both schools planted trees. St Jakobi Lutheran School planted 40 Claret Ash trees along the Lyndoch-Williamstown Road (now Lyndoch Valley Road). This ceremony was conducted by Mr Jim Cowell, Chairman of the District Council of Barossa.

The Lyndoch Primary School children planted 40 English Ash trees on the side of the Sturt Highway (now Barossa Valley Way) between the oval and the turn off to Gawler. Councillor Colin Burge spoke at this ceremony

A resident, partial to claret, whose property was along the road to St Jakobi School persuaded the school to choose the Claret Ash. The Primary School whose students were mostly of English origin were allocated the English Ash. These trees are still growing along the road sides.

The Society has not been able to locate any photographs of the occasion.

### **CREWS READY TO RESPOND... 24/7**

Your local CFS Crews are always ready to respond and train weekly in various firefighting techniques, including attending multiple specialised courses throughout the year to extend their knowledge and experience to deal with any Emergency Incidents.

Never knowing what time of day the pager may go off, there are always crews ready to assist, and as first responders we never know what might be required until we are called... The Country Fire Service is about more than just scrub and grass fires. We respond to a wide range of incidents - from dogs in dams, cats up trees, assisting other agencies, trees down, storm damage, car fires, structure fires and road crash rescues.

Within the Barossa CFS Group we comprise of six Brigades, made up of Lyndoch, Concordia, Williamstown, Mount Pleasant, Springton and Eden Valley.

Williamstown and Mount Pleasant are Road Crash Rescue Brigades with Lyndoch also being a supporting Brigade with Road Crash Rescue trained crews. Brigades also carry Breathing Apparatus and have trained crews ready to go into burning structures when persons are reported missing. Now, to increase our level of care and response for our community, all Brigades in the Barossa Group have been trained in "Advanced Resus" and carry Oxygen Therapy Kits. Selected crews have been given specialist training in Advanced Resuscitation to provide additional care for the community and for fire fighters on the fire ground. We, at Lyndoch Station are immensely proud to have crews trained in advanced lifesaving skills and to start casualty care with airway management and CPR, prior to SAAS attendance.


### SOUTHERN BAROSSA MEN'S SHED




