

LYNDOCH HISTORICAL SOCIETY

At a Lyndoch Naming Day on 13th December 1994 the Centenary of the Lyndoch Recreation Park was celebrated. A site for the community to be involved in sport was negotiated on 20th September 1894 at a meeting held in the Travellers' Rest Hotel. It was attended by Rev Brooksbank and Messrs D. Nicholas, C. Juncken, H. Kennedy, W., A., and E. Springbett where it was decided to lease 9 acres from the South Australian Company for 14 years at an annual rental of 1/-.

It was decided to mark the occasion with the planting of an oak tree in the park which became known as the "Centenary Tree". It was donated and planted by District Council of Barossa Chairman, Mr Ian Ross. The planting took place at 6.00 p.m. and those attending then enjoyed light refreshments in the pavilion.

Last year 2024 the "Centenary Tree" reached the 30 year mark but there was not the opportunity to hold an event to acknowledge the fact as the redevelopment of the Lyndoch Sports Park was underway. A clean canvas was required and the many trees were removed for the new design to take place. Hopefully the historic nature of the "Centenary Tree" with its plaque will allow it to survive as a memorial to the original complex.
