

Do you want to be able to recognise the signs that someone is struggling, or in crisis, and do you want the skills to be able to help them. **Seeds of Hope Suicide Prevention Network** is working with **Mates in Construction** to provide FREE training workshops, which will teach you how to do this.

1 DAY WORKSHOP - safeTALK

Suicide Alertness For Everyone (safeTALK) workshop will be held:

- . on Wednesday, 23 July 2025 from 10 am to 2 pm
- · at The Vine Inn Barossa, 14 22 Murray Street, Nuriootpa

safeTALK is a four-hour training that equips a person to be more alert to a person thinking of suicide and gives them the skills to make a difference. You will learn how to reach out to someone and how to help them keep safe, by promptly connecting them to further support. Your role as a connector is the focus of this training. Anyone 15 years or older can attend and no prerequisite experience, training or qualifications are required.

2 DAY WORKSHOP - A.S.I.S.T

Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training (A.S.I.S.T.) workshop will be held:

- on Tuesday, 14 October and Wednesday, 15 October from 9 am to 4:30 pm
- at The Vine Inn Barossa, 14 22 Murray Street, Nuriootpa

A.S.I.S.T. is a two-day in-person workshop featuring powerful audiovisuals, discussions, and simulations. This workshop will increase your willingness, confidence, and capacity to provide suicide first aid. The training is shown to increase general counselling and listening skills. Two knowledgeable, supportive trainers will train you, ensuring a comfortable and safe learning environment. Anyone 16 years and older can attend.



ACCESS & IDENTIFICATION TO YOUR PROPERTY

Time can make all the difference to saving lives, and a four to five minute delay in locating your property could result in a different outcome. Walk out the front of your home and see how easy it would be to find your home in an Emergency – especially at night.

Sometimes numbers to properties have been broken, damaged or sun bleached and are easily forgotten because YOU know where you live.... but do Emergency Responders?

So, read the following questions and if you answer 'NO', then it's time to make changes to ensure Emergency Services can find your property and gain access, if needed.

- Does your home display a clear number on the street to identify your home. Y / N
- Are the tree limbs and shrubs cut back enough to allow a Fire Appliance or Ambulance through to your home.
 Y / N

SLOW DOWN TO 25 KM/H EMERGENCY VEHICLES & ROADSIDE SERVICE VEHICLES



On 19th May 2025 the new Road Law came into effect that all vehicles must slow down to 25km/h when passing ANY roadside service vehicles with a flashing amber (orange) light.

Vehicles such as stationary tow trucks, roadside breakdowns and even Lyndoch's very own Wildlife Rescue Crews working to recover injured wildlife. Think of other's safety when you see the flashing amber light - just slow down to 25km/h.

Penalties apply for exceeding 25km/h for the following:

- Emergency Vehicles with 'Red and Blue' lights flashing.
- Stationary Service Vehicles with 'Amber' lights flashing.




