

The topic is turning the clock back one hundred years to 1925 to gain an idea of what the local community was experiencing at the time.

GAWLER SHOW SHIELD —

The Gawler Show Society set up a competition for the local Agricultural Bureau groups to enter providing an exhibition of their local produce in the Gawler Show. A shield was the winning prize and could be kept by the group that won the competition on three occasions.

1929 -


The Lyndoch Agricultural Bureau was presented with a silver shield for winning the inaugural best bureau display at the Gawler Show.

1930 -

The Lyndoch Agricultural Bureau was presented with the shield for the second successive occasion, having again won best bureau display at the Gawler Show.

1931 -

Members of the Lyndoch Agricultural Bureau celebrated the outright winning of the twenty guineas silver shield for the third successive time at the bureau display in the Gawler Show. (The shield is on display in the Lyndoch Institute.)


