#### Delivering Concordia's future

The Barossa Council has welcomed the State Government's finalization of the Code Amendment for the Concordia Growth Area, which includes the release of the Concept Plan and details on the Concordia Basic Infrastructure Scheme.

This development is expected to provide 12,000 new homes and accommodate up to 30,000 residents over the next 30 years. Mayor Bim Lange praised the Malinauskas Government's proactive planning approach, ensuring essential infrastructure is planned

and funded alongside development.

The Council has collaborated extensively with stakeholders to plan for critical community and social infrastructure, such as recreation, cultural, and sporting facilities, complementing the State's infrastructure plans for education and emergency services.

The project also includes shared path networks and multiple precincts to enhance liveability. Rezoning the land is part of the Premier's Housing Roadmap, with work expected to begin by 2027 and the first homes constructed by 2029.

#### LYNDOCH HISTORICAL SOCIETY

The Next meeting of the Historical Society will be held on Sunday 26th October at 2.00 p.m. in the meeting room at the rear of the Lyndoch Library.

The topic is turning the clock back one hundred years to 1925 to gain an idea of what the local community was experiencing at the time. The residents at that time were dealing with the technology of wireless broadcasts and a continuous telephone service.

The district, even then, was concerned with the issue of funding the Health System. Towards the end of the year a Gawler Charity Carnival was held to raise funds for the benefit of the Hutchinson Hospital and the Gawler Branch of the district Trained Nursing Society. Lyndoch's contribution was due to the effort of Miss Barkley, the popular postmistress who secured the cooperation and assistance of residents in the establishment of an afternoon tea table that raised £9/13/6 and also personally collected £24 towards the appeal.



The Bunyip in December included a report that the continuous telephone service had been established at the Lyndoch Exchange, and is proving a boon to subscribers and public generally.

#### Sandy Creek Uniting Church Wildflower Walk

The Sandy Creek Uniting Church wildflower walk was enjoyed by about 20 people on Thursday, September 25th.

On a sunny afternoon the walk began with a welcome in the church at which Leonie Hobbs, a volunteer at Para Wirra and Sandy Creek Conservation Parks spoke about a prescribed burn held last November. She explained that, after careful assessment, prescribed burns were held to reduce undergrowth. They are "quick and cool" but there could be some impact on the wildflowers this Spring.

After driving to the Barossa Goldfields, the group were able to view a good range of native plants, including orchids. Because of the dry year, some species were not seen, but others not

usually seen had come into flower. The bright yellow Yam Daisy was such a plant. Fortunately the prescribed burn had not impacted most of the track where the wildflowers were growing.

Back at the church, a slide

show of wildflowers from past years made use of photos taken by Phil Afford. During the afternoon tea, Dr David Taplin, chairperson of the church council thanked Leslee Carle and Leonie Hobbs for the contribution they had made to the success of this event and presented each with a gift. The Wildflower walk has been held annually for the past 45 years.


