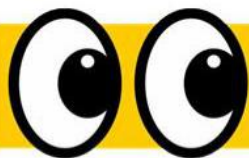

Declutter and Save is back!

The Barossa Council is again offering a hard waste kerbside collection service or waste voucher to eligible residents, with the kerbside collection service now extended to more areas! Register now by contacting Solo Resource Recovery on [8159 5053](tel:81595053).

This is a residential program, designed to help residents to dispose of unwanted and larger household items at a reduced cost. Waste vouchers can also be used for cleaning up garden waste.

The kerbside collection service is available in the townships of Angaston, Eden Valley, Lyndoch, Moculta, Mount Pleasant, Nuriootpa, Penrice, Sandy Creek, Springton, Stockwell, Tanunda and Williamstown; with parts of Kalbeeba, Concordia, Cockatoo Valley, Bethany, Vine Vale, Light Pass and additional areas of Williamstown now also included - ask Solo about new kerbside eligibility when registering for the program.

If you are confirmed for a kerbside collection, a Solo Resource Recovery vehicle will collect your items on a nominated day in May 2026, from the kerbside directly outside your house. See FAQs on The Barossa Council website for list of eligible

items and how they need to be placed to keep everyone safe. Rural and township residents who are unable to secure a kerbside collection are eligible for a waste voucher. This provides you with the choice to bring items to Springton Transfer Station or Eco Waste Solutions Willaston before 30 June 2026.

Registrations close 22 May 2026.

Terms and conditions apply*. A limited number of collections and vouchers are available and issued on a first in basis. If you chose to claim a voucher during the 'Declutter and Save' promotion held late last year, you are ineligible to participate this time.

Fire Danger Season – Ended 30th April 2026 – Still Dry Conditions

From midnight on the 1st May 2026, the Fire Danger Season officially ended in the Mount Lofty Ranges. We must still use common sense if, or when lighting a fire, as Regulations still apply, and above average temperatures have occurred around the State in the last couple of weeks.

It is likely that many of us have stockpiled rubbish ready to burn and we would like to remind residents of the following:

FIRSTLY: THINK FIRE SAFETY!

1. Please ensure there is a four (4) metre cleared space around and above your rubbish heap.
2. If you think your rubbish heap is too big or too close to trees or buildings, make several smaller piles in safer areas. Smaller piles are likely to burn more efficiently anyway.
3. Please ensure you have a rake or shovel on hand together with a water hose that is capable of reaching to the far side of the fire.
4. Please do not leave the fire unattended at any time.
5. Please be considerate of your neighbours with regards to wind direction and smoke.



SECONDLY: THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) HAS STRICT RULES FOR DOMESTIC BACKYARD BURNING!

1. Backyard burning is only allowed **Monday to Saturday** (Not Sundays).
2. Fires **must not be lit before 10am**.
3. Fires **must be completely extinguished by 3pm**.
4. **Only perfectly dry wood, paper and pruning's can be burnt** in a clean hot burn.
5. Leaves, lawn clippings and other garden refuse should be composted or disposed of via the "Green Waste" pickup service. The Barossa Council encourages these options.
6. It is an offence to burn Treated Pine and items containing plastics.
7. Smoke that is offensive to neighbours is reportable.
8. The only fires allowed at night are home heaters and outside fires principally used for cooking or "comfort fires" not exceeding 1 metre by 1 metre, using clean dry wood.
9. Penalty - on the spot fines may be issued by The Barossa Council or the EPA.

PLEASE NOTE:

- **These are EPA Regulations, not CFS or The Barossa Council regulations.**
- **The Barossa Council administers the Regulations along with the EPA and SA Police.**
- **The local CFS Fire Brigade only puts out the fires.**

If you require further information on domestic or rural burning, pick up a "fact sheet" from your local Council Office or call The Barossa Council on 8563 8444.


