Car Boot Sale *by Geoff Graetz*

The Sandy Creek Car Boot Sale was held on Saturday 9th May on a day when rain was forecast. Instead of the outdoor sites, the church and hall were set up for the stall holders.

The cake stall and the book stall were as popular as ever and other sites enjoyed sales from a steady stream of visitors. Many enjoyed the Devonshire morning teas in the hall and the barbequed sausages for sale under cover outside the church.

At the front of the church, the buskers Chris Alway, Arlo Yip and Shane Hennessy entertained the shoppers.

The proceeds of the cake stall were used to assist provision of extra time for the Pastoral Care Worker at Sandy Creek Primary School. The Devonshire tea proceeds were donated to the church's Frontier Services work supporting the work of Bush Chaplain Sunny Kadaparambil. He travels the entire upper north and west of SA providing pastoral care and practical aid to remote communities. Volunteers organised by Sunny provide practical help that is hard for people to access. He has organised a group of volunteers from Sandy Creek Uniting Church to travel to Cowell on Eyre Peninsula in the coming months.



Members of the congregation were pleased with the day, especially as the forecast rain did arrive later in the morning. This year marks 16 years since the church held its first car boot sale. They continue to be a valuable community event.

CAN WE ACCESS TO YOUR PROPERTY?

Time can make all the difference to saving lives, and a four-to-five-minute delay in locating your property could result in a different outcome. Walk out the front of your home and see how easy it would be to find your home in an Emergency – especially at night.

Sometimes numbers to properties have been broken, damaged or sun bleached and are easily forgotten because YOU know where you live.... but do Emergency Responders?

So, read the following questions and if you answer 'NO', then it's time to make changes to ensure Emergency Services can find your property and gain access, if needed.

- Does your home display a clear number on the street to identify your home. **Y / N**
- Are the tree limbs and shrubs cut back enough to allow a Fire Appliance or Ambulance through to your home. **Y / N**
- Is there enough room to allow a Fire Appliance or Ambulance to drive down your street with no obstructions. **Y / N**

SLOW DOWN TO 25 KM/H EMERGENCY VEHICLES & ROADSIDE SERVICE VEHICLES



On 19th May 2025 the new Road Law came into effect that all vehicles must slow down to 25km/h when passing ANY roadside service vehicles with a flashing amber (orange) light.

Vehicles such as stationary tow trucks, roadside breakdowns and even Lyndoch's very own Wildlife Rescue Crews working to recover injured wildlife. Think of other's safety when you see the flashing amber light - just slow down to 25km/h.

Penalties apply for exceeding 25km/h for the following:

- Emergency Vehicles with 'Red and Blue' lights flashing.
- Stationary Service Vehicles with 'Amber' lights flashing.



LYNDOCH HISTORICAL SOCIETY

To celebrate the Sesqui-centenary [150th] of South Australia a carnival was held in Lyndoch's main street on 31st March 1986. It was called '**Federweisser Fest**' celebrating the end of grape harvest and was attended by 3000 people. Lyndoch's main street was closed to traffic for five hours to allow for the carnival of wine tasting, food stalls and entertainment to take place.

[The title translates as 'white feather festival' and is the name of a partly fermented alcoholic beverage drunk at grape harvest time. It derives its name from the whitish appearance of small yeast particles floating in the liquid which give the appearance of small white feathers.]



The local businesses, wineries and community groups had stalls set up on both sides of the roadway (Barossa Valley Way). There was a display in the Institute of historical material and antique musical instruments provided by the Historical Society and Tom Coxall, owner of the Musical Museum.



The Historical Society's next meeting will be held on Sunday 2nd August at 2.00 p.m. in the meeting room at the rear of the Lyndoch Library. The topic for the occasion is the 75th Anniversary of the Jubilee of Federation that occurred in 1951.


