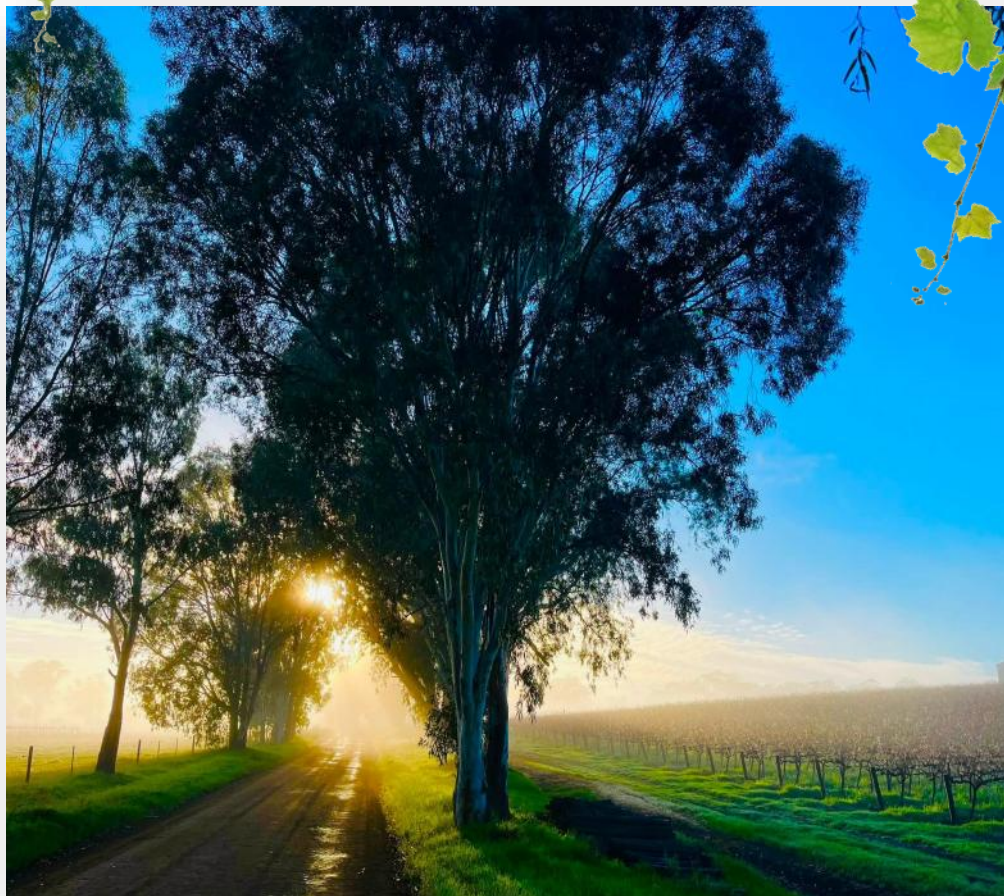

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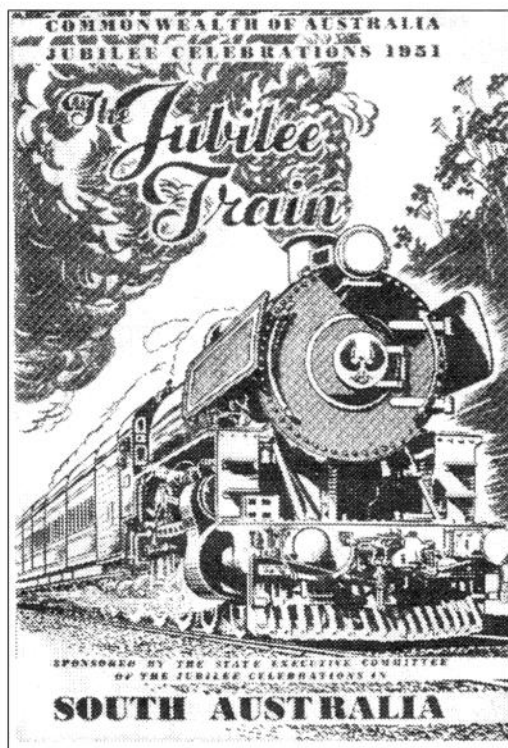
LYNDOCH HISTORICAL SOCIETY

JUBILEE TRAIN 1951

The Historical Society's next meeting will be held on Sunday 2nd August at 2.00 p.m. in the meeting room at the rear of the Lyndoch Library. The topic for the occasion is the 75th Anniversary of the celebration of the Jubilee of Federation in 1951.



Made up of nine full sized carriages, the train carried many exhibits, working models, and pictorial records arranged by many government departments and the branches of the armed services. All seating had been removed from the carriages and the available space taken up by the extremely interesting and in many cases, entertaining exhibits.



A courteous staff of forty ably answered the many queries from the public. The train was stationed at Lyndoch from 9.30 a.m. until 12 noon, during which time 2,500 visitors inspected it. Barossa District Council chairman, J.K. Barritt, declared the train open for inspection.

Members of the Lyndoch Agricultural Bureau and CWA provided an official luncheon for 130 guests, including train staff, representatives of Bureau branches, the District Council and various local bodies.

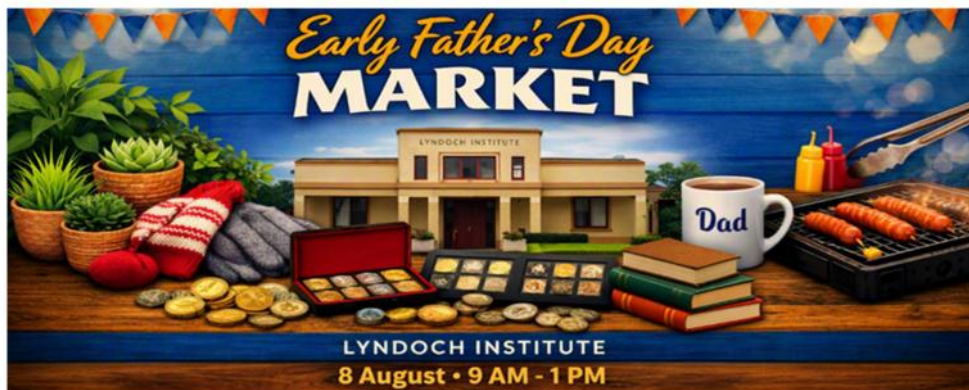
Cover of Booklet promoting the Jubilee Train Visit to Lyndoch in 1951

Launched as part of the annual Libraries SA Firstival program, the competition offers three categories: Children, 12 years and under with a word limit of up to 500; Youth, 13-18 years, up to 1500 words and Adults, up to 3000 words.

Event organisers Jodie Doyle, Library Programs Officer, and Michelle Knynenburg, Coordinator Library Experience and Programs, are looking forward to reading an abundance of submissions from which they'll shortlist finalists to be judged by an independent panel.

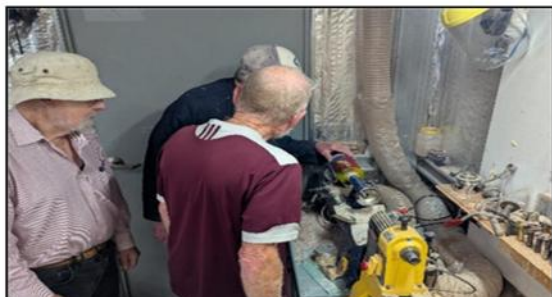
